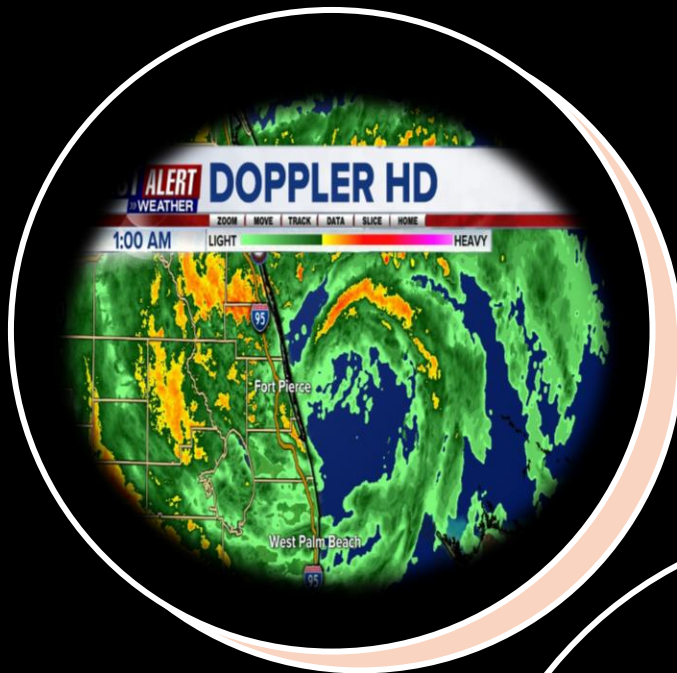

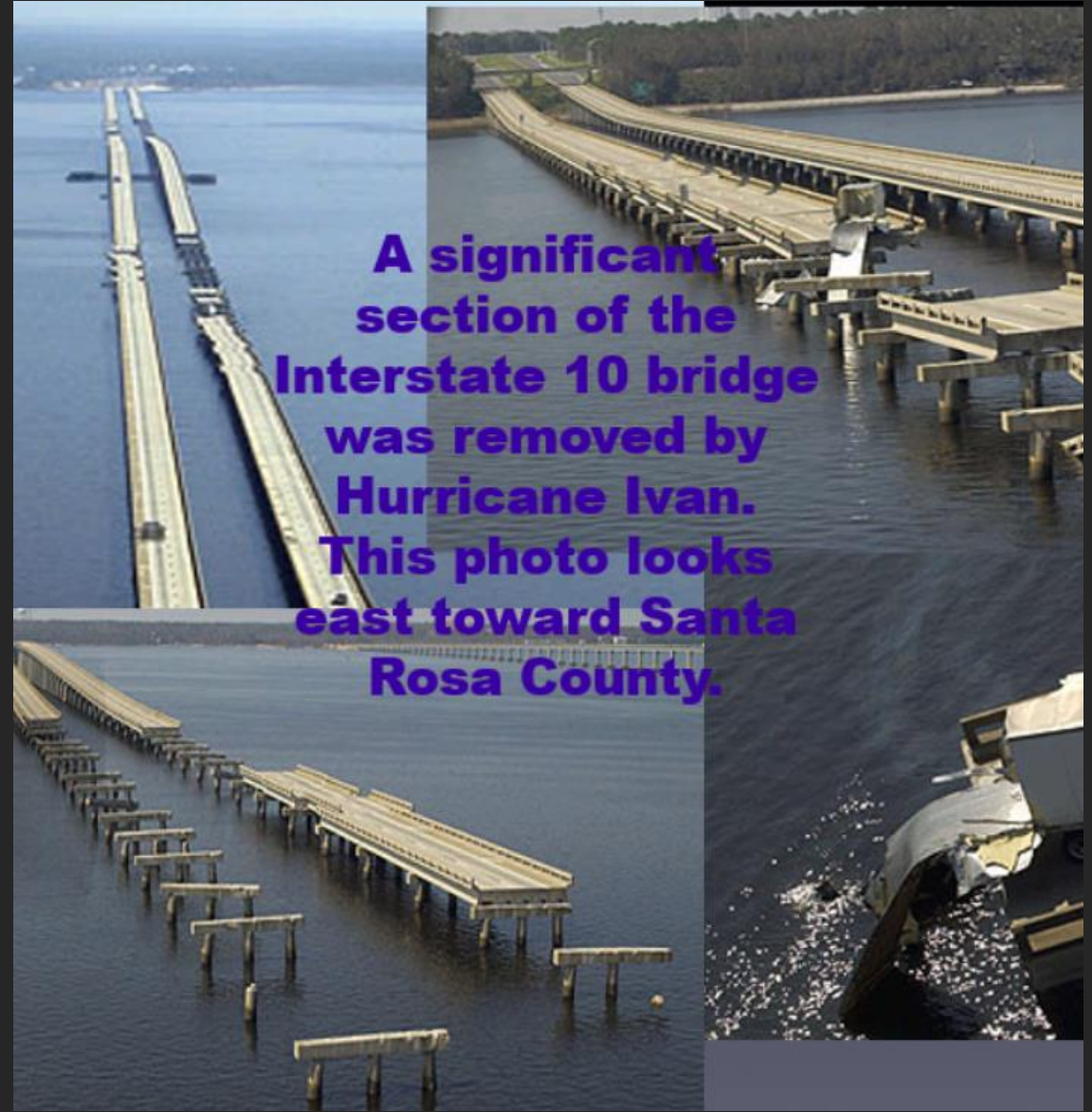

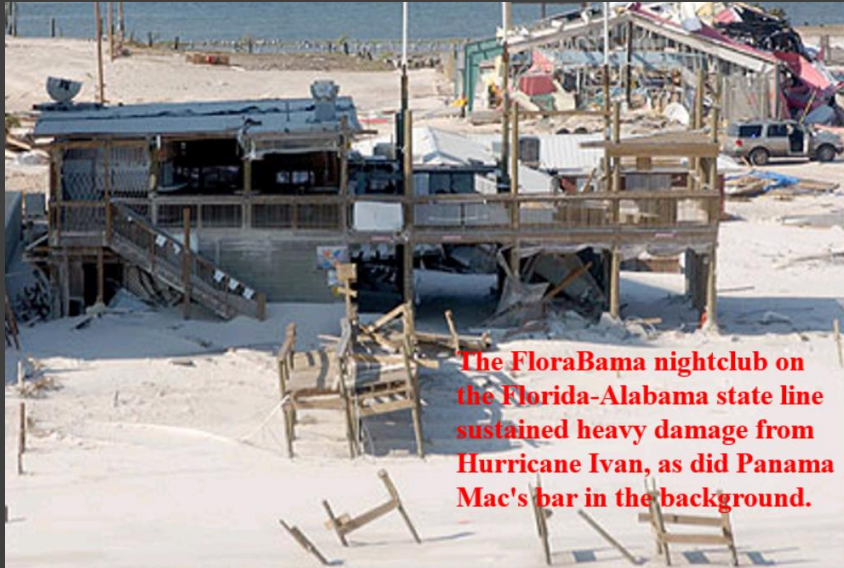

The FloraBama nightclub on the Florida-Alabama state line sustained heavy damage from Hurricane Ivan, as did Panama Mac's bar in the background.



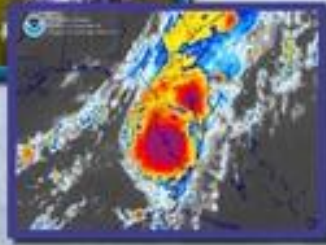

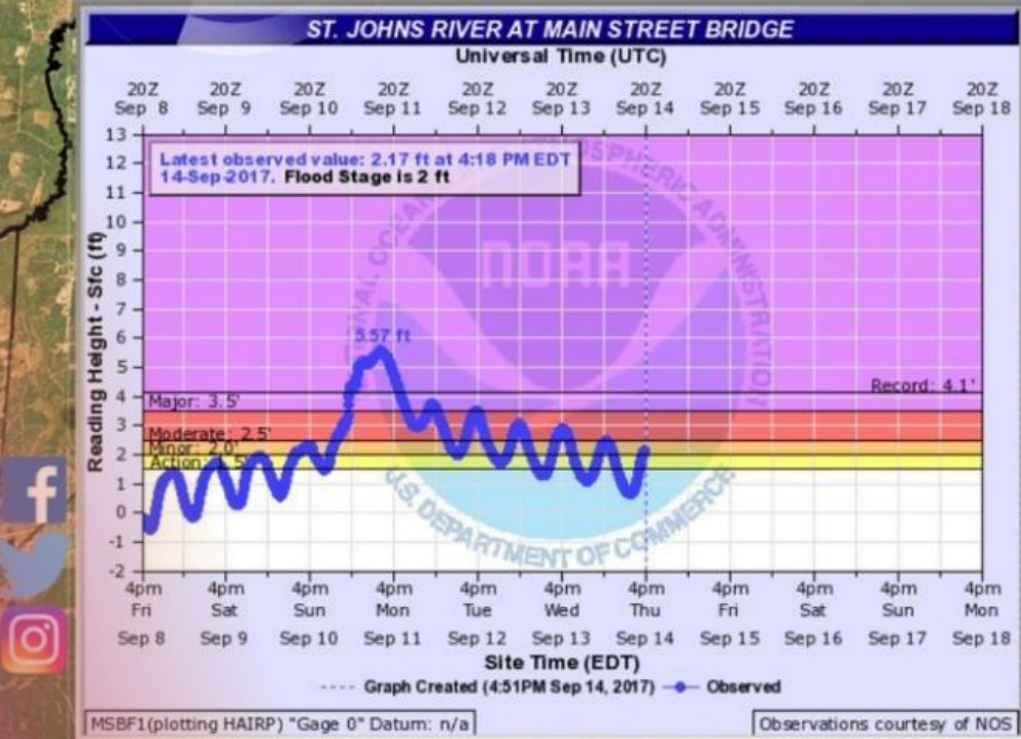

First Alert Storm Tracker





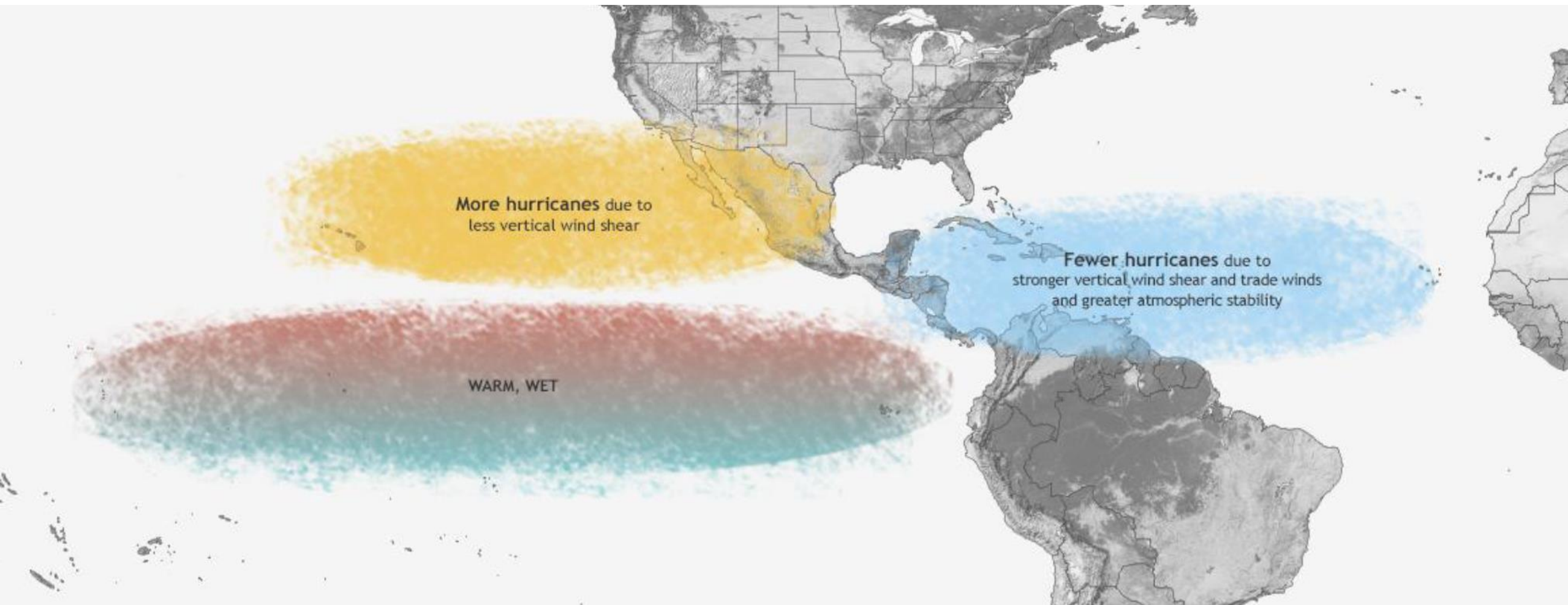

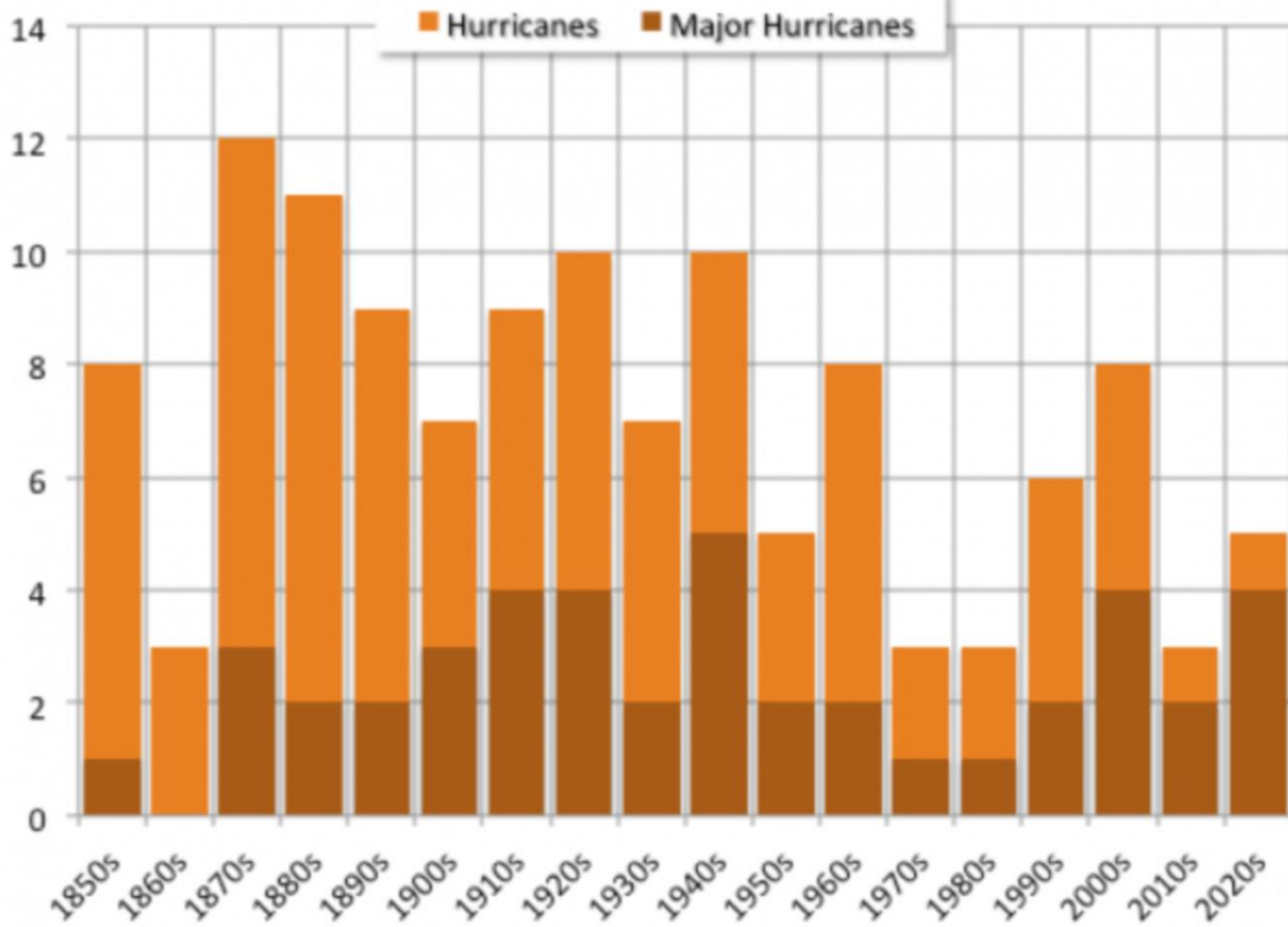
